I was walking back to my house from the shop and heard shouting and swearing coming from near my house. I turned into my road and Jo and a group of 4 others of about the same age were sat on my front wall drinking cider. There were 2 females and 2 males. They were shouting at people who walked past and throwing empty cans at them. I heard Jo shout out to my neighbour "you stupid f***ing old man, shut the f*** up and f*** off". I walked over to them and asked them not to sit on my wall. Jo laughed and threw a cider can into my garden. I asked him to pick it up and he said f***ing pick it up yourself you stupid cow. I went inside my house to call 101. After about 10 minutes they went inside number 12. This made me feel scared and reluctant to leave my house if I could see they were outside.	101 Incident number 627
02/06/16	10.30pm	12.45am	Joe from number 12 and 11 friends. They were aged 18 – 25 and there were 7 males and 4 females.	Music started at number 12 when Joe and his friends went back in the house but I ignored it and turned up my TV. At about 10pm more of Joe's friends turned up and the volume increased. At 10.30pm Jo and his friends went out into the road and started throwing beer cans around in the street. They were throwing sticks at cars and shouting and swearing. Joe went inside the house and turned up the music. His friends were running up and down the road. Jo went to their garage and brought out his moped. He started riding it up and down the pavement, kicking cars as he went by. One of my neighbours went out and asked the group to keep the noise down. Jo rode up to them and shouted "what the f*** are you gonna do about it? Shut up and f*** off". I went inside and called the Police as I was scared that someone might get hurt.	999 – the Police arrived and broke up the group. They turned off the music and took Joe away. I spoke to PC James and gave a statement.
